

## Guidelines for Exercising the Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory Option

### (I) For students admitted in or before 2007

CS students can exercise the Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) Option for up to a maximum of 12 AUs (over a span of 4 years) from any graded courses listed below.

CS students can exercise the Option **every semester** and up to a maximum of 4 AUs per semester.

All courses read on an S/U basis are excluded from the computation of CGPA, i.e. all 'S' and 'U' grades obtained will not be credited towards the degree fulfillment.

A course will be indicated 'S' if the final grade obtained is a 'C' or better, otherwise a 'U' grade will be assigned.

All S and/or U grades will be reflected in students' transcripts.

Final Year Project, Professional Internship, practica courses with the Pass/Fail option and credits obtained from all student exchange programmes will not impinge on the 12 AUs worth of S/U Option.

All Minor and Second Major courses are excluded from the S/U Option.

For the award of a degree, a student must fulfill all the programme requirements and should have acquired at least 144 AUs (inclusive of all exemptions, Satisfactory and Pass credits) of which a minimum of 77 AUs must be graded courses.

The Honours classification will be based on the CGPA point that is computed from all the graded courses.

### (II) For students admitted in and after 2008

For CS students who are admitted in and after 2008, there will be **NO CAP** on the no. of AU **per semester or academic year**. Only the University's cap of 12 AUs over 4 years shall apply. CS students can exercise up to a max of **12 AUs in a go at any one semester**. CS students **will be able to carry forward unused AUs** to the following semester or academic year.

However, please note that you **cannot** exercise this option on your CORE or PE course **but only for** your GER-PE and UE courses only.
