However, if you are adding the courses to waitlist (i/e. not registered yet), should there be clashes among your choices 1-5, STARS will accept your choices upon your submission. This is because although you are allowed to place 5 choices on waitlist, the system will only allocate you one course (if any). The system will also check that this course will not clash with any of your core and major prescribed elective courses that you have already registered.

You must register the compulsory or failed courses if they are offered. If you were to submit your planned timetable consisting of both failed courses and other courses from STARS Planner to STARS, STARS will register your failed courses first and then proceed to register your other courses. If you are registering your courses directly into STARS, the system will not allow you to register other courses first before you register your failed courses.

Some courses may only be taken by students who have obtained at least the specified grade in certain related courses offered at a lower level. These lower-level courses are called the “pre-requisites” for the higher-level courses. You are not permitted to take a course which has a pre-requisite unless you have obtained a minimum of grade ‘E’ (for pre-GPA grading system) or ‘D’ (for GPA grading system) in the prerequisite course.

Student interested to take up language courses (such as Japanese, Korean, Malay, French and German) must have passed/be exempted from the English Proficiency course.
