

Travelling Time

Computation of the travelling time is based on the first four digits of each postal code. The estimated travelling times and the corresponding weightings are as follows:

Weighting	Travelling Time
3	< 35 mins
4	< 50 mins
5	< 65 mins
6	< 80 mins
7	< 95 mins
8	< 110 mins
9	>= 110 mins

Students may refer to the postal code table.

For local students, the travelling time shall be based on the distance between the address as registered on the NRIC and the university.

International students, who do not have any local home, will by default be considered as requiring the longest travelling time.

Note:

The hall office will verify the NRIC address as and when necessary. If there is a discrepancy in the address that the applicant has furnished the university with, the hall resident's status of tenancy may be removed. Local applicants will be warned that providing a false address on the NRIC is a criminal offence punishable under the National Registration Act.
