Terms And Conditions

- The member's authorisation to the CPF Board for the use of his CPF savings for the above mentioned student shall cease upon the approval of the revocation request by the CPF Board. Please note that tuition fees that are deducted before the approval of the revocation request shall continue to be paid to the Approved Educational Institution.
- The student will remain liable to repay to the member's CPF Account all the CPF monies withdrawn for the course including the accrued interest that would have been earned if the withdrawal had not been made. The repayments must be made in cash, or using the available funds in the student's Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA).
- The student and the member will be informed of the commencement of the repayment. Repayment by the student will commence one year from the date of completion of the course or one year from the date the student leaves the Approved Educational Institution, whichever is the earlier.
- After approval of the revocation request, the member is required to complete a new application form (AES/F1) if he would like to re-apply to use his CPF monies to pay for the student's tuition fees.
