From 2014 to 2016, the team saved trees that were felled to make way for new Halls, the Experimental Medicine Building, and the Clinical Sciences Building. Led by Faith Teh and Caroline Pang, the timber was processed, enabling artists and designers to create more than 50 pieces of artworks and furniture that filled campus spaces, including at The Hive. An exhibition co-presented by Faith and Caroline attracted over 10,000 visitors. It was extensively reported in the media, illustrating NTU's innovative way of giving new life to felled trees.
