It is essential to control the purchases of goods and materials into SPMS for the various reasons:

How does this impact me as an user to the proposed goods or materials to be purchased?

It helps you as the user to further understand the safety requirements before using the item or materials. With proper safety conditions fulfilled, we can have a safer environment for all. This is in addition to compliance with the laws.

a. Ensuring legal compliance such as the application of various permits or licenses from the governing authority



- b. Ensuring statutory
 equipment passed the
 inspection by an
 Authorized Examiner (AE)
 before putting into use
- c. Controlling the hazardous material quantities to be within the permitted amount given on the permits or licenses
- d. Ensuring the required infrastructure (if applicable) is installed or constructed to facilitate the safe use of the hazardous materials
- e. Prompt for the required safety training for person who need to operate or use the equipment or materials
- f. Prepare for the emergency response equipment needed where the hazardous material is to be used
- g. Trigger for risk mitigation measures to better manage the risk in the School


