Over 6,000 jobs and internships to be offered at NTU Singapore Career Fair

Opportunities include those under NTU's new Management Associate Programme

Over 6,000 job and internship openings will be on offer at the career fair held at **Nanyang Technological University, Singapore (NTU Singapore)**, with more vacancies expected to be added over the course of the Fair, amid concerns of an economic slowdown and slightly tempered hiring optimism among employers here.

Among the career opportunities available at the Fair is the new **NTU Management Associate Programme**, NTU Singapore's two-year flagship programme launched today for fresh graduates and young working professionals who wish to pursue a meaningful non-academic career in the higher education sector.

Held in-person over three days on 2, 7, and 9 February, and virtually from 2 to 16 February, the **NTU Career Fair 2023** is the largest since the pandemic and will see over 350 Singapore and multinational organisations on the hunt for graduating NTU students to fill up full-time and internship positions.

Aside from representatives from the NTU Management Associate Programme, other participating employers at the annual Fair include tech companies such as TikTok, IBM International, and Hewlett Packard, and global engineering companies such as Rolls Royce and Continental.

On the launch of NTU's Management Associate Programme, NTU Senior Vice President (Administration) Ms Tan Aik Na said: "NTU is recognised internationally for excellence in teaching, research, and innovation. The number of job opportunities available at this year's career fair underscores this. Universities are built on the diverse talents and contributions of their people. While attracting high-quality faculty is essential for the universities' success in education, research, and innovation, it is also crucial to have a team of talented professionals who are able to create and facilitate an effective ecosystem to enable that success. The NTU Management Associate Programme is our flagship programme for fresh graduates and young professionals

who share our ambition – "to contribute to nurturing leaders and creating social impact through interdisciplinary education and research".

Speaking at the opening ceremony of the NTU Career Fair 2023, **NTU Deputy Provost (Education) Professor Tan Ooi Kiang,** said: "The strong interest by employers in NTU's Career Fair despite a cautious economic outlook speaks to the quality, relevance, and value of an NTU education, which aims to inculcate in all NTU graduates the three 'C's – cognitive agility, character, and competence – through interdisciplinary learning, and experiential and collaborative learning. As a result, our students continue to be sought after by employers, with the latest Graduate Employment Survey showing more than nine in 10 NTU graduates from the Class of 2021 were employed within six months after completing their final examinations."

Nurturing bright sparks for a meaningful career in higher education

The **NTU Management Associate Programme (MAP)**, which commences in July 2023, is designed to attract bright, talented fresh graduates and young professionals with fewer than three years of working experience.

This programme showcases the wide range of career opportunities beyond teaching at NTU and serves as a springboard for success in higher education management and non-academic careers.

Under this two-year programme, each cohort of 10 to 15 Management Associates will gain valuable experience and build a broad spectrum of skills through at least two job rotations that expose them to various aspects of university management. They will play key roles in implementing and advancing **NTU 2025**, the University's five-year strategic plan to achieve its education, research and innovation ambitions and goals, by contributing fresh ideas, pushing boundaries, and creating meaningful change.

Management Associates will receive mentoring from experienced leaders, benefit from a development plan that is tailored to their needs and closely aligned with their career aspirations and have access to comprehensive learning resources to support their growth.
