 - Upload of documents will still be available after you have completed online verification

- **Official Verification Report (Mandatory)**

Applicants who are presenting overseas credentials / degrees **are required** to obtain an official verification report from an NTU approved credential verification agency.

2. International students

a. Student Pass (For Full-Time International Students)

Collection of Student Pass

For Full-Time International students holding IPA letter who are residing in Singapore currently, you can make e-appointment with ICA to collect your Student Pass.

Note: Please do not make any early travel plans without IPA letter.

b. Immigration Pass (Part- time International Students)

International Students who are not a citizen or Permanent Resident of Singapore must ensure that they possess a valid immigration pass issued by ICA or Ministry of Manpower (MOM) to study and reside in Singapore throughout the entire period of their studies.

3. Pre-enrolment Medical Check-up

As part of the onboarding process for new students, **all students must undergo a Pre-enrolment Medical Check-up prior to admission** to determine their medical fitness to pursue the chosen programme of study at the University.

Only **part-time** postgraduate students will be exempted from the pre-enrolment medical check-up.

Students may complete the medical check-up at **Raffles Medical** clinics using the options below.

For International Students

Mandatory Pre-enrolment Medical Check-up for Student's Pass

The Singapore Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) require all international students to undergo a Pre-enrolment Medical Check-up, including an HIV test and a chest X-ray for Tuberculosis clearance, as part of the Student's Pass application process.

International students may complete the required Pre-enrolment Medical Check-up at any licensed medical clinic in their home country. The test results (translated in English) must then be endorsed by Raffles Medical for a fee to activate your student medical insurance¹. This endorsement must be completed before the start of your programme.

Raffles Medical may charge for additional tests if the reports provided by the licensed medical clinic does not meet the requirements (for instance X-Ray image did not carry a label bearing the name of the student)².

Special note: All international students should upload the Medical Examination Report in their home country for early approval of student pass application.

6. Fees

a. MOE subsidy

MOE subsidy only applies to Singaporean and Singapore Permanent Resident (SPR) students. International students enrolled in Coursework Programmes under S. Rajaratnam School of International Studies (RSIS) programmes are still eligible for MOE subsidy. The subsidy is capped at the normal course duration of 1 year for full-time students and 2 years for part-time students. Students who take longer than the normal course duration will be liable for non-subsidised fees during the extended semesters.

International students enrolled in other Coursework Programmes will be liable for non-subsidised tuition fees.

Students who have previously enjoyed MOE subsidy in a graduate programme will not be eligible for MOE subsidy in another graduate programme at the same or lower level.

b. Tuition fees

The bill for tuition fee and miscellaneous fees will be sent via email by the NTU Shared Services - Finance (NSS-Finance) approximately within 2 weeks upon commencement of classes.

Candidates who withdraw from the programme within the first 2 weeks of the first semester/trimester shall not be liable for Tuition Fee and Miscellaneous Fee. Candidates are expected to have sufficient funds to cover all the expenses of their entire period of study.
