



# Master of Science (Managerial Economics)

Master of Science in Managerial Economics (MME-E) aims to develop students in strategic thinking and managerial decision making in the context of business, government and society. Taught in English, the programme builds students' ability in integrating economic theory with management practice to meet challenges faced by public and private sectors.

This one-year interdisciplinary programme builds students' knowledge in economic theory, sharpen their techniques in designing effective and impactful policies, and extend their ability to provide sound managerial advice in their respective professions. It aims to give students a competitive advantage in becoming a strategist — charting organisational goals with sound policy formulation and analytical decision-making — in small and medium enterprises (SMEs), large international corporations, as well as institutions in the public sector.

The Mandarin-taught MME programme, which started in 1998, has benefited many Chinese government officials with its practical approach. Building on the success, MME will now also be offered in English and receive its inaugural intake in January 2021.



## PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

Students need to complete 10 courses, comprising 2 core courses and 8 electives, to graduate. Students who fulfil academic requirements can take on a capstone paper in lieu of 2 full electives. The programme offers both full-time and part-time study.

### Unique Economics Masters Programme

The programme is designed with an emphasis on the application of economic and managerial theories to reinforce organisational strategies. Students will acquire advanced knowledge and skills to support decision-making and forward planning, empowering them to rise to the challenges of today's world.

The curriculum and structure of MME-E combined with our multidisciplinary faculty and practitioners give students an all-round learning experience. Besides the academic team in NTU, our faculty also includes current and former politicians, and senior government officials in Singapore with exceptional managerial experience.

MME-E graduates will join an extensive global network of 18,000 NCPA alumni who hold decision-making positions at all levels of government in their countries, including roles such as ministerial-level leaders, mayors and heads of organisations.

## PROGRAMME FEE

The tuition fees for each local/international student is S\$32,000 (inclusive of GST). This fee excludes miscellaneous fees (health check-up, entry visa, student's pass, accommodation, meals, overseas immersion, etc.).

## SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are awarded on a merit basis. More information on MME-E scholarships is available on our website.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A bachelor's degree in good standing from an accredited university or college is required for all applicants.
- Possess such other qualifications as the Academic Board may approve.
- For students from universities where English is not the medium of instruction, a good IELTS/TOEFL test score is required. The minimum test score is as follows:

Type of Test	Minimum Test Score
IELTS	Score of 6.5 Min 5.5 for each skill module
TOEFL	Paper-based: 580 Computer-based: 230 Internet-based: 88-89

- Existing final year undergraduate students may apply for admission with a softcopy of their provisional degree certificate and/or yearly examination results to date. Original degree certificate and academic transcripts/complete yearly results must be provided for verification at the point of matriculation.
