Frequently Asked Questions

Eligibility Criteria

1. Can all students apply for CTS Education Awards?

All full-time students studying in MOE-Approved institutions who are Singapore Citizens / Permanent Residents are eligible to apply. Bursary applications are open to all students from Primary to University whereas Scholarship applications are only open to students from Institutes of Higher Learning (ITE, Polytechnic and University).

2. What is the criteria for CTS Education Awards (Bursary and Scholarship)?

There are no specific criteria in terms of the minimum PCI and scores for Bursary and Scholarship Applications respectively. Since, the applications will be considered in competitive merit based on the pool of applications received for the current year, the criteria is bound to change every year. Thus, students are welcomed to apply for the awards with the necessary supporting documents as stated in the Checklist Forms.

3. Can I apply for both scholarship and bursary?

Only students from Institutes of Higher Learning can apply for both Bursary and Scholarship. For that, they need to submit two different application forms online. As both applications are processed independently, it is much appreciated if students can attach two sets of the required supporting documents with the two checklists accordingly. While students can apply for both Bursary and Scholarship, they will be awarded only one. If they qualify for both, the award with the higher quantum will be presented.

4. Can I apply for CTS Bursary or Scholarship while receiving another Bursary or Scholarship?

On the part of CTS, there are no restrictions to other Bursary / Scholarship recipients applying for CTS Educations Awards. Nevertheless, applicants may wish to clarify with existing sponsors on such reservations, if any.

5. If I am applying for both scholarship and bursary, do I need to submit two sets of supporting documents?

As both applications are processed independently, it is much appreciated if students can attach two sets of the required supporting documents with the two checklists accordingly. While students can apply for both Bursary and Scholarship, they will be awarded only one. If they qualify for both, the award with the higher quantum will be presented.

6. Is there a hardcopy application form?

No, all applications are to be submitted via the Online Form. Supporting documents should be mailed to the Temple Office with the Checklist Form.

10. Are there any bond or commitment in lieu of the Scholarship or Bursary?

For CTS Education Awards, there are no bonds or commitment required on the part of awardees.

11. How will the award be disbursed?

The awards will be presented via Giro Transactions (PayNOW) after the awards ceremony. The awards ceremony will be held in January 2024.
