### Sourcing for sand sustainably in South-east Asia

NTU Singapore scientists from the [Earth Observatory of Singapore](#) (EOS) and the [National Institute of Education](#) (NIE), led by Assistant Professor Edward Park, have developed an innovative monitoring system that offers precise measurements of sand mining activities in the Mekong Delta. The team is developing a sustainable sand harvesting map aimed at identifying regions in the Mekong Delta where sand naturally accumulates. This map will play a crucial role in preventing over-harvesting, ensuring that sand extraction is both sustainable and environmentally friendly. This research is particularly relevant to Singapore's Long Island

project, addressing inland flooding and the effects of climate change.
