

Invisible Architects: Insects Role in Singapore's 'City in Nature', *Climate Transformation: Sustainable Societies Lecture Series*

RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS



Conservation of peatlands and mangroves key to reducing carbon emissions

Did you know that conserving and restoring Southeast Asia's carbon-rich peatlands and mangroves could mitigate more than 50% of the region's land-use carbon emissions? Despite covering only 5% of the land, these ecosystems store over 90% of their carbon in soils, making them highly efficient carbon sinks. The new international research study by NTU Singapore, National University of Singapore (NUS), and James Cook University in Australia highlights the importance of these ecosystems in controlling carbon emissions and promoting nature conservation.

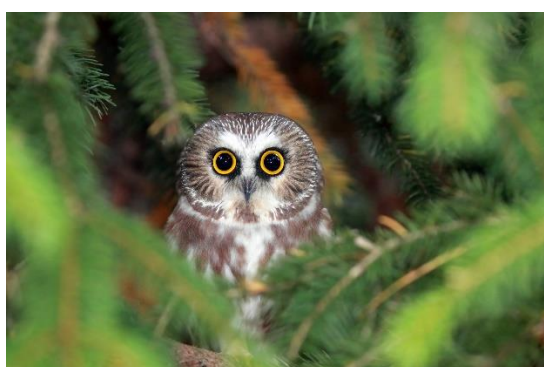


Singapore World Water Day (SWWD)
