Submit your online admission application form to NTU at www.ntu.edu.sg/admissions/undergraduate/scholarships

Applications for admission and scholarship will close on the same date.

2

Upon submission of your online admission application form, the "Application for Scholarship" link will appear.

3

Click on the "Application for Scholarship" link, key in your assigned admission application number, and complete the online application for the scholarship. You only need to complete and submit one application regardless of the number of scholarships you are interested in.

4

Submit your scholarship application. After submission, you will be prompted to upload a recent passport-sized photo.

Please inform your referee to submit the online appraisal to us within seven days. If you are given a URL, please forward it to your referee.

If you are applying for need-based scholarships, download a copy of the document checklist from the website and upload the completed form with the relevant ID and income documents.



SCHOLARSHIPS FOR EXISTING STUDENTS

SHORT-TERM SCHOLARSHIPS

- These scholarships are open to current undergraduates or freshmen on subsidised tuition fees who have performed well academically and meet the criteria specified by the donor of the scholarship.
- Freshmen may submit their online application only two days after they have matriculated online. Shortlisted candidates will be notified to attend an interview between August and September.
- The scholarships are tenable only for the academic year in which they are awarded. The value of the scholarships ranges from S\$3,000 to S\$16,000.

SCHOLARSHIP INTERVIEW

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When should I apply?

Apply for scholarships immediately after or shortly after submitting your application for admission, instead of waiting for the admission offers to be released. You are encouraged not to defer your application until after your National Service (if applicable). The admission and scholarship application windows are similar.

When will I hear back?

Interviews will take place mainly between March and May. Shortlisted applicants will be notified via email to attend an interview, so please check your email regularly.

Who will interview me?

You may be interviewed by a scholarship panel comprising academic and administrative staff. The number of panel members and composition will vary depending on the school.

What happens after the interview?

You may expect an email informing you of the outcome within two to three weeks, unless you have been informed otherwise. To ascertain when you can expect to receive the outcome, you may check with the party that sent you the interview invitation or check with the staff at the interview.

Choose an outfit that is not too casual, as it may suggest a lack of seriousness about the scholarship and the interview. Looking smart does not require a white shirt and black suit. You could opt for a coloured suit in blue or grey and a pair of well-polished shoes. In addition, showing up with a tie is always a plus.

For the ladies, if you are wearing a dress, choose one that is appropriately fitted and of suitable length, in classic shades like navy blue. Complete the look with a pair of comfortable heels. For a top-and-bottom combination, white and grey make a safe colour pairing.
