PLANNING A CHANGE TO YOUR NTU-IRB APPROVED STUDY?

DON'T FORGET TO SUBMIT AN AMENDMENT TO NTU-IRB



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An amendment must be approved by NTU-IRB **before** implementing any changes to your protocol.

Changes include:

- Study design or methods
- Data collection instruments
- Recruitment numbers
- Consent forms / procedures
- Recruitment materials
- Data handling or storage plans
- Research sites or team members

Deviations without prior approval are considered **Non-Compliances** and may result in severe penalties.
