


## CORPORATE PAYNOW: FASTER REIMBURSEMENT FOR RESEARCH PARTICIPANTS!

### What's Corporate PayNow?

Corporate PayNow is NTU's secure payment solution that allows researchers to transfer funds directly to research participants via their mobile number (preferred) or NRIC.



### What's New?

- Higher Limit:** Payment threshold raised from \$100 to \$250 per participant.
- More Capacity:** Upload up to 100 payment lines per submission (previously 50).

### Why Use Corporate PayNow?

Skip the hassle of vendor registration and bank verification. Reimburse participants seamlessly and securely with minimal inconvenience.



### How To Raise Reimbursement?

Submit requests through NTU [ServiceNow](#). Cut off time for processing is every Friday.
