

This course aims to introduce students to the fundamental concepts of designing and developing for the web and various devices with a focus on front-end design. Students will learn HTML, the core principles of CSS and be introduced to JQuery and other frameworks through hands-on demonstrations. HTML and CSS in particular are useful for introducing and easing art/design students into other coding environments and more advanced programming languages. In addition, you will be exposed to aspects of UI/UX via wireframing, prototyping.

This course prepares you for learning more advanced web development principles, working with Content Management Systems as well as hands-on, professional web development.
