## Content

You will gain an understanding of generativity as a cognitive toolset and a medium-independent creative framework, crucial for contemporary media art and design. The course covers different aspects of generativity, enabling you to develop strategies and techniques for creating your own generative artworks. You will learn about software tools and hardware devices for generative experimentation, sketching, and project development, and be inspired by a spectrum of generative art practices and aesthetics, from minimalism to creative AI and machine learning.
