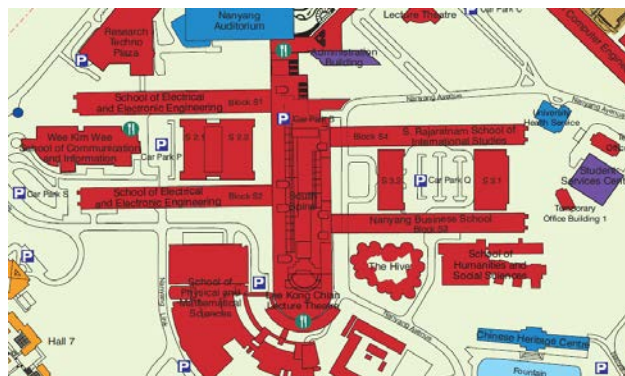

Now the School is one of the component schools under the renowned College of Engineering together with five other engineering schools.

The School has about 150 faculty with broad and varied background and strong research and professional expertise. They are supported by more than five hundred research, technical and administrative staff members. Apart from teaching the undergraduate and graduate courses, faculty members are active in research and development, engaging in a broad range of collaborations with renowned overseas universities, research institutes and multinational companies. To support advanced research, the school hosts 13 research centres and facilities which are equipped with sophisticated and state-of-the-art equipment. 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Programme Requirements

The coursework [requirements](#) for PhD student includes the satisfactory completion of 18 Academic Units (AUs) and a minimum Cumulative GPA (CGPA) of 3.5 for the total number of courses taken. This includes 6 AUs from 7000 or 9000 series courses. The MEng student requires completion of 9 AUs and a minimum CGPA of 3 for the total courses taken. This includes 3 AUs from 7000 or 9000 series courses.

In addition to the 18 AUs requirement, full-time PhD students are required to complete HWG703 (if not exempted) and HWG702 before they can proceed to the Qualifying Examination (QE) cum Confirmation of Candidature exercise. All MEng and PhD students are required to attend the Information Research and Management course within first year of candidature. MEng and PhD students are required to go through MEng confirmation exercise and QE/Confirmation of Candidature exercise respectively. With effect from Aug 2019 intake, all PhD students are required to take Communications/Writing Training programme which consists of three components, two compulsory and one optional. The compulsory components of this programme is a prerequisite for graduation. Upon the completion of the research, the candidate is required to submit a thesis on his research for examination. For the degree of Doctor of Philosophy, there is also an oral examination on the subject matter on his thesis and other related subjects.
