# Rule and Precautions for Drawing Liquid Nitrogen

## 1. Training for Drawing Liquid Nitrogen:

- Contact the Staff-in-charge to arrange the training.
- Upon approval, the users need to do the Risk assessment (SPMS) before being authorized to draw the LN<sub>2</sub> by themselves during operation hours.
- Do strictly follow the rules during handling, drawing and transporting LN<sub>2</sub>.
- ASK if there is anything you do not fully understand.

#### 2. Safety:

- Always equip with all necessary PPE include: cryogenic face shield, cryogenic gloves and suits, closedtoed shoes and ear plug.
- Use proper containers to draw LN<sub>2</sub>.
- Do not fill cylinders/dewars to more than 80% of their capacity.
- Always de-ice the pressure regulator and withdrawal line and valve properly after each top up.
- Always work in pairs.
- Do not allow any LN<sub>2</sub> to touch any part of your body or become trapped in clothing near the skin.
- Do not touch any item that has been immersed in LN<sub>2</sub> until it has warmed to room temperature.
- Never dip a hollow tube into LN<sub>2</sub> because it may spurt the liquid.
- Metals to be used for equipment in LN<sub>2</sub> must possess satisfactory physical properties.
- Report any defective to the staff-in-charge immediately and comment in the record book.
- Any spillage must be cleaned immediately and reported.
- Store LN<sub>2</sub> in well-vented areas. Do not store LN<sub>2</sub> for long periods in an uncovered container or in wet, dirty
  areas.
- Never park the LN<sub>2</sub> cylinder besides any glass object.
- Only use cargo lift to transfer LN2. Passengers shall not ride in the lift with any container of LN<sub>2</sub>. Make arrangements for someone to send the lift to a receiving person waiting on the desired floor.

## 3. Emergency contact:

- In case of any technical problems, call Mr Raman in Mechanical Workshop.
- In case of accidents, call Campus Security Division at 67905200 or Ambulance at 995.

### 4. Borrowing the LN<sub>2</sub> Central Facility key:

Ask the staff-in-charge and properly, fill in the usage charging form in the mechanical workshop. Return the key to the same staff-in-charge immediately after use.

#### 5. Punishment:

Due to the risks involved, all personnel are required to follow the rules and precautions during handling, drawing and transporting LN<sub>2</sub>. Any personnel who failed to comply these rules may be **banned to draw the**  $LN_2$  from Central Facility.
