We need evidence of your CGPA. Consult your University and provide an official indication of your grade point average

Engage a **faculty** prior to applying and enhance the quality of your research proposal

When applying...



It is important to provide your **Skype address** so that we can contact you regarding interviews. Please also provide an **email address** that you would expect to access in 6 months time.

Interviews are scheduled between Dec to Jan for shortlisted candidates

Only the **first choice** of the application will be processed. Candidates who wish to be considered for more than one subject will have to submit separate applications. Likewise to be considered for either M.A. or Ph.D. the applications have to be submitted accordingly.

Application process may take up to **4 months or more**. Offers will be made from **March till June**. All applicants will receive email notifications of the outcome of their application.
