We are looking for a motivated and talented scholar who wants to pursue a Ph.D. within the areas of **Macroeconomics and Finance**.

This individual will work within the NTU Start-Up Grant "Macroeconomic Expectations and Financial Stability" with the Principal Investigator Assistant Professor **Chua Yeow Hwee** at Nanyang Technological University (NTU), Singapore. This project aims to understand the relationship between macroeconomic expectations and the financial stability of an economy both empirically and theoretically.

The successful candidate will play an integral role throughout the entire project lifecycle, including the conduct of literature review, data collection, data analysis, developing theoretical models, and the writing of research papers.

Pre-requisites:

- A good Master's / 2nd Class Upper Honours Bachelor's Degree in Economics, Finance, Computer Science, Engineering or a related field.
- Excellent written and spoken command of English (IELTS: 7.0 Overall Score).
- GRE test scores (Minimum requirement: Verbal & Quantitative Reasoning 319 out of 340 and Analytical Writing 3.5 out of 6.0). GRE is not required from NTU, NUS or SMU graduates.
- Well written research proposal and relevant research experience or research achievements preferred.
- Programming and/or computational data analysis skills, capable of using at least one of the following: Stata, Matlab, R, Python.
- Excellent project management and multi-tasking skills.

Location of the programme:

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for interviews (via online) and the successful candidate will be expected to enroll in the Ph.D. programme for the respective intake.
