

## Curriculum for BSocSci (Hons) in Economics with 2<sup>nd</sup> Major in Business (AY2020 and onwards)

The BSocSci (Hons) in Economics with 2<sup>nd</sup> Major in Business is designed as a four-year course. To graduate, students are required to complete 135 academic units (AUs) from the General Education Requirements (GER), Econ Major Requirements (ECON) and 2<sup>nd</sup> Major Requirements.
