AU EXEMPTIONS FOR POLY STUDENTS

Very important

- 1. Applications for AU exemptions must be submitted in your **first semester** of enrolment in SSS
- 2. No exemptions will be given for the following courses:
 - Major Cores
 - Major Electives
 - GER-Cores
- 3. You may apply for up to a **maximum of 12 AU exemptions** and only for courses in the following categories:
 - a maximum of 6 AUs from GER-PEs
 - a maximum of 6 AUs from the GER-UEs

GRADUATION PROJECT

Clear your major PEs sooner rather than later.

- In order to begin the Graduation Project (HS4099 or HS4098), students <u>must</u> have completed:
 - 95 AUs (must be classified as Year 4)
 - All Major Cores
 - At least 7 Major Electives for a grade
- It is recommended that students do not take more than 3 other courses during the first semester of HS4099 or HS4098.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- 1. Freshmen GPA exemptions
 - 6 failures will be exempted from CGPA calculation.
 - Will be recorded in transcript.
- 2. Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory option
 - For GER-UE / GER-PE courses
 - courses
 - 12 AUs
- 3. Special Term



EXCHANGE MATTERS

- 1. Application to go for exchange in Year Two will take place in Year One.
- 2. A notification with details and deadlines will be sent to your NTU email.
- 3. We recommend that you go on exchange in Year 2 Sem 2 or Year 3 Sem 2 as core courses are offered in Sem 1.



EXCHANGE — REQUIREMENTS

- 1. At least **69 AUs** of **Graded Courses** must be completed in NTU.
- 2. Your **Residential Period** (physical presence) in NTU must be at least **3 years**.
- 3. All Sociology Major Core Courses must be completed in NTU.



EXCHANGE — TRANSFER OF CREDITS

- You are responsible for the transfer of credits
- A maximum of 3 courses will be counted towards fulfilling Major PEs. Only two courses at the 4000-level are allowed.
- Important note: these AUs will be pass-fail (non-graded).
- A maximum of 6 courses or 20 AUs will be transferred back to NTU (whichever is fewer)

INTERNSHIPS

Professional Attachment Programme (HPAP)

- Usually after Year 3, before Year 4.
- 10 weeks.
- 5 AUs of UEs on a pass/fail basis.
- Students can only go once on HPAP.

Note: students are encouraged take other internships but no AUs will be given.
