KM Merit Scholarship

Eligibility

- The scholarship is open to all full-time students.
- Applicants will need to be admitted to the NTU WKWSCI KM programme.
- Applicants will need to maintain a CGPA of 4.0 and complete the KM programme within 1 year.
- Applicants must be self-funded and have not received another scholarship for their KM programme's tuition fees.
- Applicants will be reviewed based on the academic excellence, leadership potential, character and integrity, potential for future impact and unique talents/ achievements.

Coverage

• Successful applicant(s) will receive either full or partial (50%) scholarship to be used towards tuition fees only.

Application Procedure

- Applicant needs to submit their complete CV, academic records, two
 recommendation letters from an academic and their current or former
 employer- and a one-page personal essay to support their application towards
 this scholarship.
- The scholarship application is open from 1st May to 31st May, and the results will be announced by July of the intake year you are applying for.
