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ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Curriculum Structure

Students admitted to WKWSCI in Academic Year 2019 must complete 127 academic units (AUs) with at least 20AUs of upper-level Major-PE spread over four years. The AU requirements of the various course types are as follows:

Student admitted in Academic Year 2020 and have earned sufficient AUs to be promoted to year 3, should register for courses during your personalised registration timing – Monday, 14 Dec 2021, 2-4.30pm. You should refer to the Study Year 2 instructions for all other information.

Graded AU Component

As part of the graduation requirement, all students are to complete at least 69 graded AUs over candidature period. AUs earned from course exemptions, exchange credit transfers, massive open online courses (MOOCs), Pass/Fail courses and S/U-ed courses are read as ungraded.

Major-PE requirement

Out of the 38 AU requirement, you need to complete at least 20AUs of upper-level Major-PE and at least one compulsory lower-level Major-PE course from the list below.

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GER-Core requirement

You need to complete all the following 1AU online course:

As these courses may be discontinued in subsequent semesters, please ensure that you complete them as soon as possible.

PROFESSIONAL INTERNSHIP (PI)

You will be registered automatically for your 22-week PI, no action is required on your end.

A PI journal is to be submitted at the end of your internship by the stipulated deadline given by CAO. Delays in submission will hinder the tabulation of scores and the updating of AUs earned on your degree audit.

Students are not allowed to register for courses during your PI semester. On an exception basis, students who have yet to complete ML0003 Kickstart your Career Success will be allowed to register for this course.

For those who wish to register for ML0003 during your PI, you will need to submit your request via this [link](#) by Monday, 6 December 2020.

EXCHANGE CREDITS

Outstanding credit transfers will affect your personalised course registration timing which may end up being less advantageous for you. If you are encountering issues in getting the transcript from the host university, please approach the school for advice.

IN PREPARATION FOR YOUR FINAL-YEAR PROJECT (FYP)

To prepare for your FYP in Year 4, all students must plan towards complete the pre-requisite courses and to earn 91AUs (including PI) by the end of Year 3 Semester 2.
