
PARTNERSHIP HIGHLIGHTS



Unlocking Geothermal Potential Beneath Singapore

A joint study by NTU Singapore, TUMCREATE, and Surbana Jurong has found subsurface temperatures of up to 122°C in Sembawang, twice the global average, indicating strong geothermal potential in northern Singapore. Supported by the National Research Foundation (NRF) and Energy Market Authority (EMA), the team is exploring Advanced and Enhanced Geothermal Systems for power generation, district cooling, and more. These developments, presented at a public symposium with global experts, signal a promising step toward clean energy and regional collaboration in geothermal innovation

Its latest Thematic Challenge Call targets up to 75% energy efficiency improvements in healthcare, retail, mixed developments, and hotels. Solution providers and research institutions are invited to co-develop next-generation cooling and ventilation technologies, especially for the healthcare sector, to achieve 25-30% energy savings beyond today's best-in-class systems.

The focus is on Human Health and Potential (HHP) or Manufacturing, Trade, and Connectivity (MTC) domains, with anticipated industry participation within 3-5 years.
