Mitsubishi Electric and NTU Singapore Partner on Advanced Grid Management Platforms

Mitsubishi Electric Corporation (MELCO), Japan, and NTU Singapore, through the Energy Research Institute @ NTU (ERI@N), have signed a strategic research collaboration focused on advanced grid management platforms. The partnership will explore clean energy mix balancing, dynamic system optimisation, and grid stability in low-inertia environments. The project will be demonstrated at the Renewable Energy Integration Demonstrator – Singapore (REIDS) testbed on Semakau landfill, featuring MELCO's BLEnDer@RE renewable energy management solution.

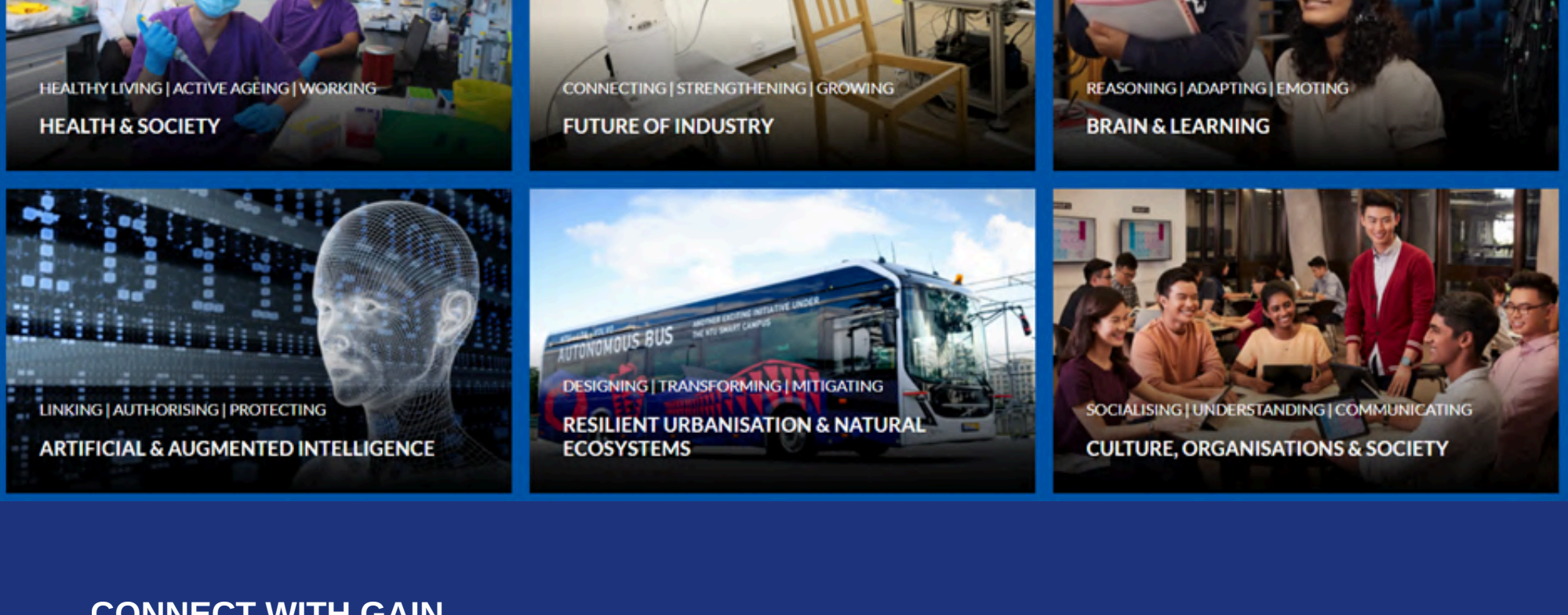
