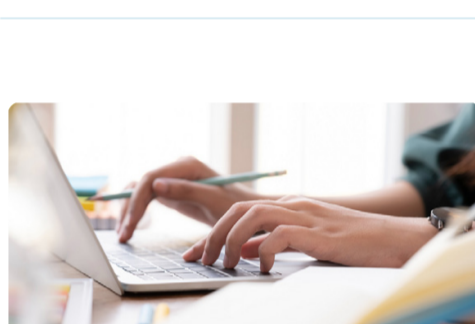


Panasonic Deep Tech Innovation Challenge

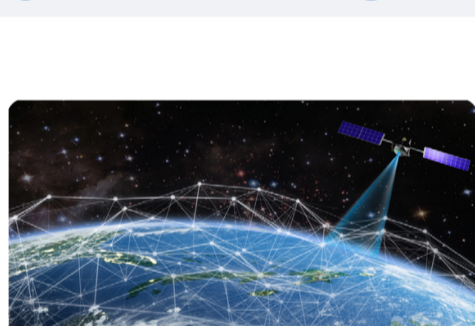


Monitoring and Measurement of Crop Health and Yield

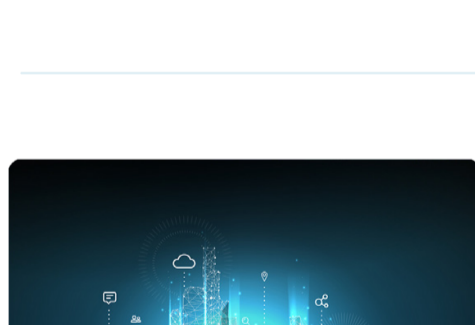

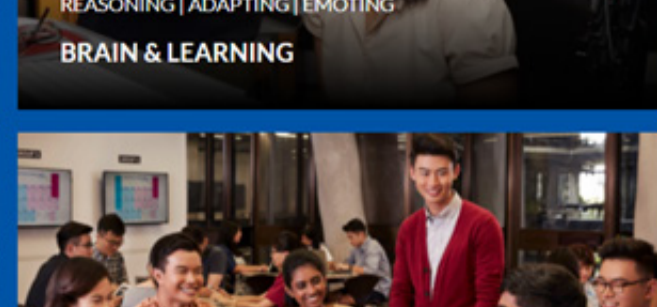
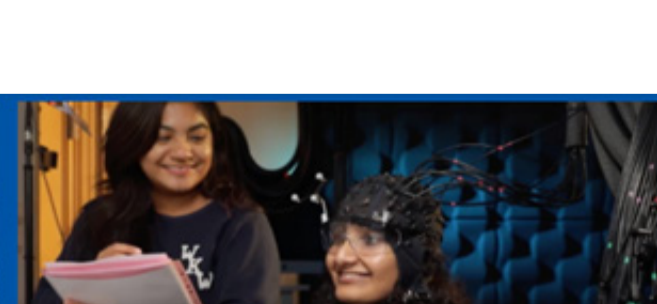
