

Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA)*

Payable with PSEA Singapore Citizens aged ≤ 30 years

National Silver Academy (NSA)*

50% NSA subsidy of the course fee Singapore Senior Citizens aged ≥ 50 years

Union Training Assistance Programme (UTAP)*

Applicable for selected courses. NTUC members enjoy 50% unfunded course fee support, capped at \$250 each year (or up to \$500 for aged ≥ 40yrs).



- New Trainees: There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$65.40 (incl. 9% GST).
- Returning Trainees: Registration fee waived within one year from the end date of the latest course attended. Applicants who last attended a course more than a year ago will be subject to the registration fee.

Customising Programme

- This programme can be customised to individual or corporate needs.
- Not eligible for government subsidies.

Discount Schemes

- 10% off course fee for NTU staff, student, alumni and NTU Alumni Club Member.
- 10% off course fee for Seniors (SPR / Foreigners) aged ≥ 50 years.
- 10% off course fee for a group enrolment of 3-4 pax full fee trainees (new and existing trainees are eligible), for a class with a min. of 8 trainees.
- 15% off course fee for a group enrolment of ≥5 pax full fee trainees (existing trainees only), for a class with a min. of 8 trainees.

Note: - Proof of identity status or relevant documents are required for verification purpose.

- Applicants are eligible for ONE discount scheme at a time.
- Discounts may not be used in conjunction with the NSA subsidy
- In the event of withdrawals in the group enrolment, group discounts would be adjusted accordingly.
