CONTENT

The objective of this course is to help graduate students develop their written and oral communication skills in English in academic settings. Participants will learn to:

- 1. prepare an academic paper for possible publication;
- 2. plan an oral presentation;
- 3. develop their skill in explaining concepts in their areas of specialization; and
- 4. respond critically, but constructively, to presentations.

HWG703 is a pass/fail course. It consists of 12 two-hour tutorials. Students who are required to take HWG703 need to pass the course before they can enroll for HWG702 (University Teaching for Teaching Assistants).
