Important Notes

- 1. All the modules are conducted online and are available at the start of the programme.
- 2. The main and supplementary course assessments (MCQ), workshops, summary training, OSCE and Final Examination Written Paper (MCQ) are conducted in-person on LKCMedicine Novena Campus.
- 3. The format of the course assessment is a 20-MCQ paper comprises of single best answer (SBA) questions.
- 4. There are two course assessment attempts for each module, i.e. main and supplementary course assessments. Students do not have to attempt two course assessments for each module. The supplementary course assessment is for students who did not manage to obtain a pass grade for the main course assessment.
- 5. The supplementary course assessment is not meant for students to be excused from the main course assessment as it is designed primarily for those who did not pass the main course assessment, to have a second chance at it. The supplementary course assessment is only open for those who are not able to attend the main assessment due to unforeseen circumstances.
 - Student who did not attend the main course assessment would only have one attempt at the course assessment for the affected modules. Any student who is not successful in obtaining a pass grade for the supplementary course assessment of any of the six online courses, would have to retake the course assessment for the specific course(s) with the subsequent cohort a year later.
 - The student will continue with the remaining components of the GDSM programme in the current intake, except for the Summary Training and the Final Examination (OSCE and Written Paper) which they will participate with the subsequent intake.
- 6. The format of the Final Examination Written Paper is a 50-MCQ paper comprises of single best answer (SBA) questions.
- 7. There is only one attempt each for the OSCE and Final Examination Written Paper (MCQ). Any student who is not successful in obtaining a pass grade for the OSCE and Final Examination Written Paper (MCQ), would have to retake the OSCE and Final Examination Written Paper (MCQ) with the subsequent cohort a year later.
