At LKCMedicine, we offer exclusive scholarship awards for our incoming MBBS students to recognise their academic excellence and leadership potential. Our scholarships are specially designed to fulfill the needs of our students.

There are two categories of scholarships available:

- ***Merit-Based Scholarships***
- ***Needs-Based Scholarships***

MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

The merit-based scholarships are awarded to candidates with exemplary academic performance, leadership qualities and conduct.

LKCMEDICINE SCHOLARSHIP

The LKCMedicine Scholarship is offered to outstanding students aiming to pursue their undergraduate MBBS programme in NTU. It is tenable for 5 years, subject to consistently good academic performance and satisfactory conduct.

Eligibility

- Singapore Citizens
- Outstanding results in GCE 'A' Levels, Local Polytechnic Diploma, NUS High School Diploma or International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma
- Outstanding contributions or attributes in other areas such as community service, student leadership, or sporting excellence

Award Benefits

- Subsidised Tuition Fees (after Tuition Grant)
- Living Allowance of \$6,000 per Academic Year (AY)
- Book Allowance of \$500 per AY
- One-off Computer Allowance of \$1,500

ASEAN UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

The ASEAN Undergraduate Scholarship is offered by NTU for citizens or permanent residents from the Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN) countries, except Singapore.

Eligibility

- Singapore Permanent Residents or Citizens from ASEAN countries (except Singapore)
- Outstanding results in GCE 'A' Levels, Local Polytechnic Diploma, NUS High School Diploma, International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma or Year 12 equivalent qualifications
- Excellent CCA records and strong leadership qualities/potential

Award Benefits

- Subsidised Tuition Fees (after Tuition Grant)
- Living Allowance of \$5,800 per Academic Year
- Accommodation allowance of S\$3,000 per academic year
- One off computer allowance of S\$1,750

NEEDS-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

In addition to academic excellence, qualities and conduct, preference for needs-based scholarship will be given to students who demonstrate financial need.

Students applying for these scholarships would be required to submit their family income documents to NTU Financial Aid for verification.

TOH KIAN CHUI SCHOLARSHIP

The Toh Kian Chui Scholarship is tenable for 5 years, subject to consistently good academic performance and satisfactory conduct.

Eligibility

- Singapore Citizens
- Outstanding results in GCE 'A' Levels, Local Polytechnic Diploma, NUS High School Diploma or International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma
- Outstanding contributions or attributes in other areas such as community service, student leadership, or sporting excellence
- Preference will be given to students from lower income families

Award Benefits

- Subsidised Tuition Fees (after Tuition Grant)
- Living Allowance of \$6,000 per Academic Year (AY)
- Book Allowance of \$500 per AY

IRENE TAN LIANG KHENG SCHOLARSHIP

The Irene Tan Liang Kheng Scholarship is offered to provide opportunities to deserving Singaporean students. The award is tenable for 5 years, subject to the recipient maintaining consistently good academic performance and satisfactory conduct.

Eligibility

- Singapore Citizens
- Outstanding results in GCE 'A' Levels, Local Polytechnic Diploma, NUS High School Diploma, International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma
- Strong academic achievement, demonstrate desire to serve the community, possess compassion, and commitment to pursuing medical studies and medicine
- Preference will be given to students from lower income families

Award Benefits

- Covers up to \$30,000 for each Academic Year

SIM YUNG CHONG MEDICAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Sim Yung Chong Medical Scholarship is tenable for 5 years, subject to consistently good academic performance and satisfactory conduct.

Eligibility

- Singapore citizens or Singapore Permanent Residents
- Outstanding results in GCE 'A' Levels, Local Polytechnic Diploma, NUS High School Diploma, International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma
- Outstanding contributions or attributes in other areas such as community service, student leadership
- Preference will be given to students who demonstrate financial need and who are able to speak Mandarin

Award Benefits

- Covers up to \$15,000 for each Academic Year

BURSARIES

Bursaries are available for financially-needy students pursuing their MBBS programme at NTU. To be eligible to apply, you should meet either of the following criteria (with effect from AY2023-24):

- Per Capita Income (PCI) is less than or equal to \$2,500 per month **or**
- Gross Household Income (GHI) is less than or equal to \$10,000 per month

The PCI is calculated as follows:

$$PCI = \frac{\text{Gross Household Income (GHI)}}{\text{Total No. of Family Members in Household}}$$

*GHI refers to income before CPF deductions. It includes income, allowances, overtime, commissions and other sources of income by family members residing in the same household as the applicant.

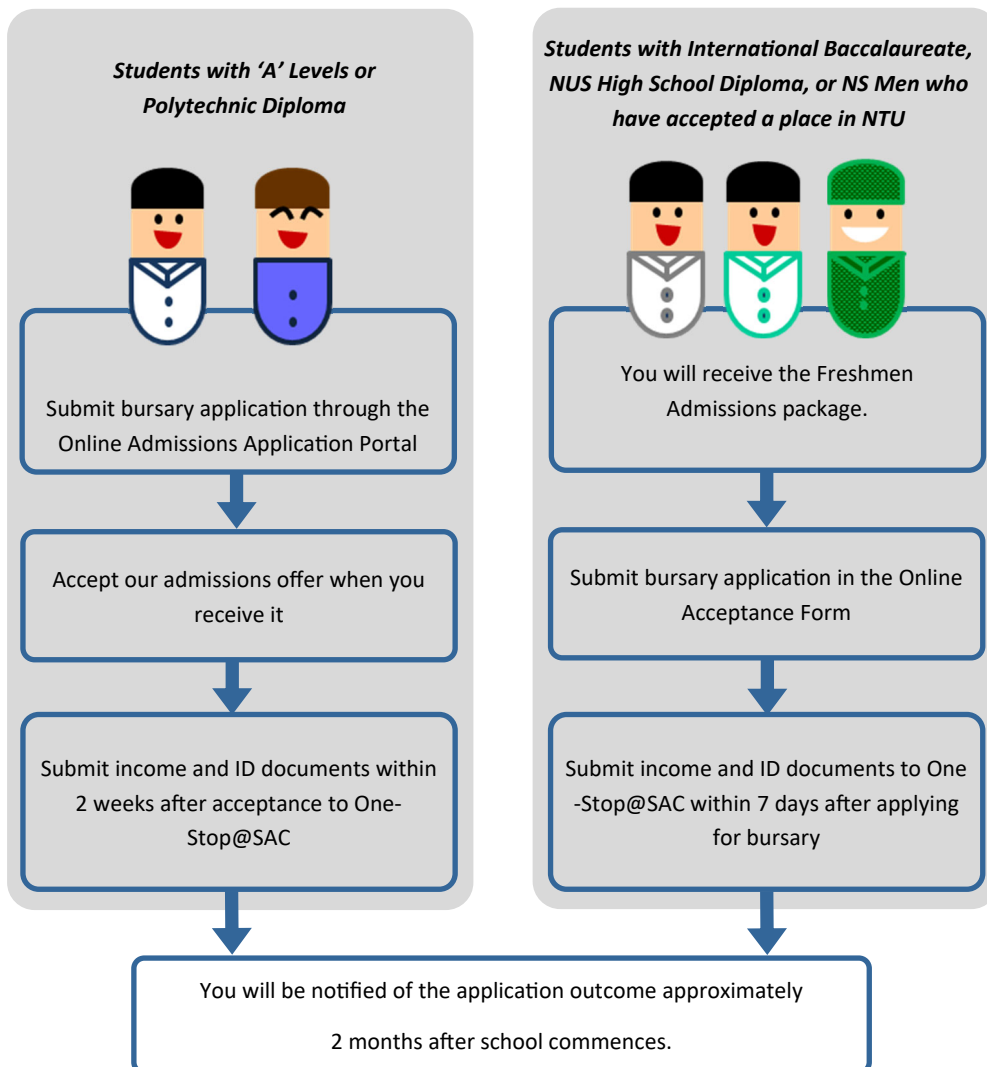
Note:

Students receiving the above bursaries may concurrently hold other bursaries or grants subject to approval by LKCMedicine. Please note that the total bursary amount (including other concurrent bursaries/grants) a student receives should not exceed the award cap for Tier One bursary.

HOW TO APPLY

Students who meet the eligibility criteria for the bursary may submit their applications through the online admissions application portal between February to April each year.

The bursary shall be tenable for the duration of the student's completion of the MBBS programme, subject to the candidate providing annual evidence of continued financial need.



MORE FINANCIAL AID SCHEMES

NEEDS-BASED GRANTS

Besides offering bursaries to financially-needy students, LKCMedicine offers its own needs-based grants.

Grant	Eligibility Criteria	Award Amount
LKCMedicine Overseas Elective Travel Grant	Year 5 students undertaking overseas electives, with PCI ≤ \$2,500 or GHI ≤ \$10,000	Up to \$5,000 per Grant
LKCMedicine Emergency Grant	Students with sudden/unexpected personal crises affecting their financial situation	Up to \$10,000 per Grant

EXTERNAL FINANCIAL AID SCHEMES

Students may also apply for financial aid from external organisations such as the Singapore Medical Association (SMA) Medical Students' Assistance Fund.

Eligibility Criteria	Award Amount
<p>Open to Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents.</p> <p>Students who have been awarded bursaries from LKCMedicine are also eligible for the SMA Medical Student's Assistance Fund (SMA-MSAF Bursary), subject to review and approval by LKCMedicine and SMA.</p> <p>Please note that the total bursary amount (including SMA-MSAF Bursary) a student receives should not exceed the award cap for their financial aid tier.</p>	<p>Living allowance of \$5,000 per academic year.</p> <p>All disbursements will go directly to the students for their basic living expenses and will not be used to offset any outstanding tuition fees.</p>
