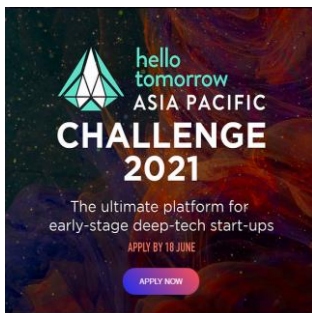


Edex Teaching and Learning Grant - 1st Call for Application
