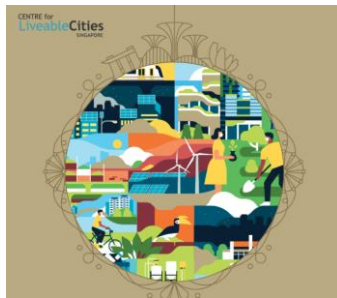

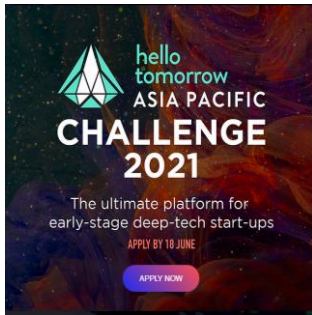


ELI Grant Call 1 : Connecting Communities: Changing Times, Changing Needs (1st ELI Grant)
