This programme provides a broad-based course of study in the field of applied linguistics, mainly within the fields of language education and language studies, balancing theoretical knowledge with practical application. It helps individuals to develop a strong foundation in theories of linguistics and language learning by providing them with opportunities to critically review current research in applied linguistics.

Target Audience

Primarily for English language teaching professionals who wish to strengthen their academic qualifications for career advancement, but it is also suitable for individuals with a keen interest in language-related issues.

Entry Requirement

- A good undergraduate degree in English Language Studies, OR
 - A good undergraduate degree in a related field with a postgraduate diploma in English Language studies;
- · Teaching qualifications and teaching experience, while preferred, are not required for admission.
