

TUITION FEES GRADUATE (COURSEWORK) FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME PROGRAMMES FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

APPLICABLE TO AY2022-2023 INTAKES ONLY (August 2022 and January 2023 Intakes)

1. All fees listed below are in Singapore dollars (S\$). Every academic year, fees are reviewed and subject to revision. As and when fees are revised, the new fees will be applicable to all existing and new students.
 - a. The tuition fee students admitted in AY2022/2023 intake will be the same throughout the normal course duration as cohort-based fees is introduced from AY2022/2023.
 - b. Tuition fees for students admitted in AY2020/2021 and AY2021/2022 intakes will be adjusted by \$50 per annum for Singapore Citizen (SC) and Singapore Permanent Residents (SPR) students, and \$100 per annum for International Students (IS) for the remaining course duration.
2. There are two semesters in an academic year. Fees payable every semester must be paid in advance and within the stipulated period.
3. Students who fail to pay fees within the stipulated periods can have their names struck off the register of higher degree students. A student whose name has been thus struck off but who is otherwise eligible to continue his candidature will be reinstated only after he has settled all outstanding fees and paid a re-registration fee of S\$53.50.
4. A student who withdraws or leaves the University two or more weeks after the commencement of his candidature or the commencement of the semester is liable to pay tuition fees and miscellaneous fees due for the entire semester.
5. The University's Board of Trustees reserves the right to alter fees at any time without notice.
6. There are other miscellaneous fees payable at the time of matriculation. Please refer to the section below on "[Miscellaneous Fees](#)" for more details.
7. Notes on Goods and Services Tax (GST):

For Master of Education Programme (MOE-subsidised) and Master of Teaching:

- a. For Singaporeans and Singapore Permanent Residents, the tuition fees are exclusive of GST. The GST for these students is borne by MOE.
- b. For international students and non-subsidised students, unless otherwise stated, the tuition fees are inclusive of 7% GST and payable by students. From 1 January 2023, the GST will be increased to 8%.

For all other graduate programmes:

- c. Tuition fees are inclusive of 7% GST. From 1 January 2023, the GST will be increased to 8%.

Programmes Subsidised by the Ministry of Education, Singapore

Eligibility Guidelines for Ministry of Education (MOE) Subsidy

10. The substantial tuition subsidy from the Government of Singapore comes in the form of a MOE subsidy which is administered by the Ministry of Education (MOE) and is offered to all admitted students in eligible Masters programmes up to the normal programme duration. Students need not apply for the MOE subsidy if they are eligible.

10.1 Period for MOE Subsidy

For Master of Education (all specialisations) and Master of Teaching, the MOE subsidy will cover up to the normal course duration for part-time and full-time mode of studies for the following intakes:

10.2 Students with a Higher Degree Qualification

Students who have previously enjoyed MOE subsidy or government sponsorship in a graduate programme will not be eligible for MOE subsidy in another graduate programme at the same or lower level. Instead, such students will be liable to pay “Non-subsidised Fees” for the graduate programme that they now wish to undertake. For example, students who had previously enjoyed MOE subsidy in a Masters programme and had attained the Masters degree will not be eligible for subsidy in another programme at Masters degree or lower level. In addition, if they wish to upgrade in another discipline area where the programme has a combination of Masters and PhD candidature, they will not be eligible to enjoy MOE subsidy during the Masters candidature.

10.3 Transferred or Re-admitted

Students who are transferred or re-admitted within NTU or across Autonomous Universities * may not be eligible for MOE subsidy for the full normal programme duration for the new programme, depending on the number of semesters of MOE subsidy received from the previous programme.

*Autonomous Universities refer to NTU, National University of Singapore (NUS), Singapore Management University (SMU), Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT), Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD) and Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS).

SkillsFuture Mid-Career Enhanced Subsidy for Singapore Citizens aged 40 years and above

11. With effect from 1 July 2015, Singapore Citizens (SC) students aged 40 years and above will pay fees that are 60% lower than the standard subsidised fees payable by other Singaporean students who are below 40 years old. However, this is not applicable to students paying non-subsidised fees.

Total Tuition Fee (by Course Rate)

* The total tuition fee for each programme is based on the total number of components (i.e. course, practicum and dissertation, where applicable) for the entire programme at the applicable per-course rate for the Academic Year. In general, practicum and dissertation components are each equivalent to two courses. Fees are billed on a semester basis for the number of courses (or equivalent) registered in the semester. The per-course rate is subject to yearly revision. Students have to pay for any component that they have to repeat.
