

## **TUITION FEES GRADUATE (COURSEWORK) FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME MOE-SUBSIDIZED PROGRAMMES FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023**

### **APPLICABLE TO EXISTING INTAKES**

#### **(A) Notes on Tuition Fees**

1. All fees listed below are in Singapore dollars (S\$). Every academic year, fees are reviewed and subject to revision. As and when fees are revised, the new fees will be applicable to all existing and new students. For MOE-subsidised programmes, the tuition fees are exclusive of Goods & Services Tax (GST). Except for tuition fee payable by International and Non-subsidised Students, the GST for these programmes will be borne by MOE. For international students under subsidised programmes, the tuition fees are inclusive of 7% GST and payable by students. From 1 January 2023, the GST will be increased to 8%.
2. There are two semesters in an academic year. Fees payable every semester must be paid in advance and within the stipulated period.
3. Students who fail to pay fees within the stipulated periods can have their names struck off the register of higher degree students. A student whose name has been thus struck off but who is otherwise eligible to continue his candidature will be reinstated only after he has settled all outstanding fees and paid a re-registration fee of S\$53.50.
4. A student who withdraws or leaves the University two or more weeks after the commencement of his candidature or the commencement of the semester is liable to pay the fees due for the semester.
5. The University's Board of Trustees reserves the right to alter fees at any time without notice.
6. There are other miscellaneous fees payable at the time of matriculation. Please refer to the section below on "[Miscellaneous Fees](#)" for more details.

#### **Eligibility Guidelines for Ministry of Education (MOE) Subsidy**

7. The substantial tuition subsidy from the Government of Singapore comes in the form of a MOE subsidy which is administered by the Ministry of Education (MOE) and is offered to eligible students **up to the maximum candidature period** (unless otherwise stated). Students need not apply for the MOE subsidy if they are eligible.

7.1 From AY2020 intakes onwards, MA (Applied Linguistics), MSc (Life Sciences), MSc (Exercise and Sport Studies) have been converted to non-subsidised programmes.

## 7.2 Period for MOE Subsidy

With effect from AY2020 for all new intakes for the following programmes, the MOE subsidy will cover **up to the normal course duration** for part-time and full-time mode of studies for the following intakes:

<b>Part-time</b>	2 years

With effect from AY2019 for all new intakes for the following programmes, the MOE subsidy will cover **up to the normal course duration** for part-time and full-time mode of studies:

## 7.3 Students with a Higher Degree Qualification

Students who have previously enjoyed MOE subsidy in a graduate programme will not be eligible for MOE subsidy in another graduate programme at the same or lower level. Instead, such students will be liable to pay “Non-subsidised Fees” for the graduate programme that they now wish to undertake. For example, students who had previously enjoyed MOE subsidy in a Masters programme and had attained the Masters degree will not be eligible for subsidy in another programme at Masters degree or lower level. In addition, if they wish to upgrade in another discipline area where the programme has a combination of Masters and PhD candidature, they will not be eligible to enjoy MOE subsidy during the Masters candidature.

## 7.4 Transferred or Re-admitted

Students who are transferred or re-admitted within NTU or across Autonomous Universities\* may not be eligible for MOE subsidy for the full normal programme duration for the new programme, depending on the number of semesters of MOE subsidy received from the previous programme.

\*Autonomous Universities refer to NTU, National University of Singapore (NUS), Singapore Management University (SMU), Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT), Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD) and Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS).

## **SkillsFuture Mid-Career Enhanced Subsidy for Singapore Citizens aged 40 years and above**

8. With effect from 1 July 2015, Singapore Citizens (SC) students aged 40 years and above will pay fees that are 60% lower than the standard subsidised fees payable by other Singaporean students who are below 40 years old. However, this is not applicable to students paying non-subsidised fees.

  - a. Tuition fees for students admitted in AY2020/2021 and AY2021/2022 intakes intake will be adjusted by \$50 per annum for Singapore Citizen (SC) and Singapore Permanent Residents (SPR) students, and \$100 per annum for International Students (IS) for the remaining course duration.
- 2) For Singaporeans and Singapore Permanent Residents under subsidised programmes, the tuition fees are exclusive of GST. The GST for these students is borne by MOE.
- 3) For international students under subsidised programmes and non-subsidised students, unless otherwise stated, the tuition fees are inclusive of GST and payable by students. Where tuition fees shown exclude GST, GST is applicable and payable by students.

- Candidates who withdraw from the programme within the first 2 weeks of the first semester shall not be liable for the Tuition Fee, and Miscellaneous Fees. Candidates who withdraw from the programme after the second week shall be liable for payment of Tuition Fee, and Miscellaneous Fees due for the entire semester.
