

MASTER OF ARTS (Applied Psychology)

The Master of Arts (Applied Psychology) aims to produce graduates who will become leaders in the field of psychological practice.

It is designed to provide theoretical knowledge and research insights as well as practical skills to interested individuals who have the pre-requisite qualifications to train as specialists in the fields of Educational Psychology, Counselling Psychology and Clinical Psychology. Students will be able to register with the Singapore Register of Psychologists upon graduation.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE & CONTENT

The programme offers three specialisations and successful applicants are only offered one specialization and cannot switch specializations during the course of the programme.

Awards at the National Institute of Education are structured in terms of Academic Units (AU). The Master of Arts (Applied Psychology) comprises 57 AUs. The 57 AUs include 5 core courses, 3 or 4 specialisation core courses, three practicums, and a dissertation. Students may also choose to take a maximum of two optional courses.

COURSEWORK

Depending on specialization, students are required to complete a minimum of 8 to 9 courses (24 AU) in total: 5 core courses and 3 or 4 specialisation core courses. The courses may range from 13 hours to 52 hours in the 13 week-semester in which they are offered. 1 AU courses are typically completed over 2 full 6.5-hour days in the week during the first or second week of the semester, while 3 and 4 AU courses will be conducted over the 13-week semester.

In addition to the above, students may also take up to two optional courses worth 3-AUs each. Do note that these optional courses do not count towards graduation requirements.

PRACTICUM

Students are also required to complete three practicum placements (27 AUs), of which the first practicum must be completed in their existing workplace from January to 30 October during the first year of study. Students will also clock practicum hours during coursework assignments with real clients and special activities in NIE.

DISSERTATION

Students must write a research-based dissertation (6 AU) of between 12,000 to 15,000 words.
