Student's Pass matters

- All International Students who have been offered a place into our full time programme will be notified to apply for Student's Pass.
- Application can be done by logging into the 'Apply/Renew Student's Pass for Institutes of Higher Learning' portal at the Immigrations and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) website at www.ica.gov.sg under E-Services and Forms.
- For the issuance of Student's Pass, students are required by the Immigrations and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) to pass the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and Tuberculosis medical tests.

Student Accommodation

On-Campus Housing

- Full-time NIE graduate students may apply for graduate housing in NTU.
- Admission to NTU halls is by balloting.
- Priority is given to incoming new graduate students on research programmes who have not domiciled in Singapore before. In view of limited places on campus, submitting an application does not guarantee a place.
