Group Endeavours in Service Learning

Group Endeavours in Service Learning (GESL) is a service-learning community outreach programme of the National Institute of Education (NIE). It aims to strengthen character and build a sense of citizenship. GESL involves community outreach and engagement and gives our student teachers the opportunity to serve and to learn from the community. The community becomes our teacher.

GESL develops readiness in student teachers to take on leadership roles in their school's community involvement initiatives and service-learning. It provides a platform for student teachers to understand themselves better, develop multicultural skills and gain a good understanding of the communities and effective ways of community engagement.

The Meranti Project

The Meranti Project aims to help student teachers develop better self-awareness and to better appreciate how to work with diversity in the classroom.

With the aid of activities such as informal open sharing sessions that facilitate deeper exploration of self, student teachers are given opportunities to share their personal thoughts, beliefs, values and experiences with their peers in a safe environment. Student teachers also experience the core competencies of social emotional learning during the programme.
