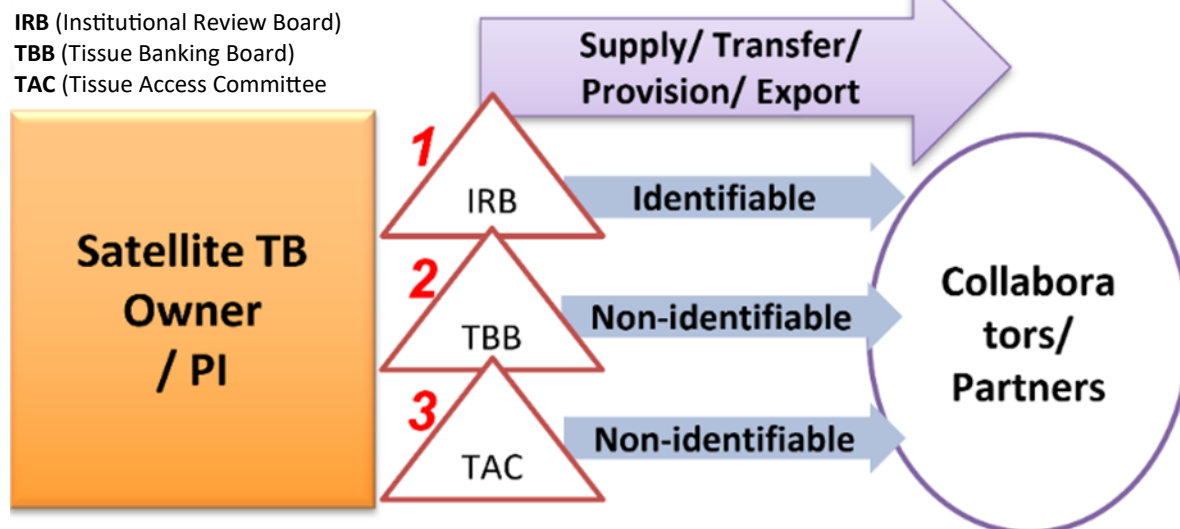

Connecting Research with Ethics

Planning to supply or transfer **Human Tissues** to NTU/non-NTU **Collaborators** for use in research?



As required by the **Human Tissue Framework (HTF)** of the Human Biomedical Research Act (HBRA), Researchers must ensure the following before supplying **Human Tissues**:

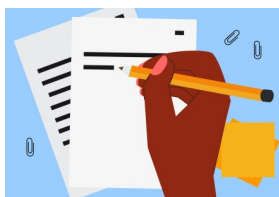
Individually Identifiable Tissues

- a) An **IRB ①** has approved the proposed research that the tissue would be used for; *and*

Non-Identifiable Tissues

- a) **NTU-TBB ②**, or a **TAC ③** if available, has approved the proposed research based on scientific merit; *and*

- b) **documentary evidence*** is provided by the recipient that they will use the tissue in accordance with the conditions/restrictions specified as part of the donors' consent.



NEW Updated MTA Template

Use the latest ***Material Transfer Agreement (MTA) template** by LSO (updated clause 3.3) to fulfil HBRA's requirement for "documentary evidence". The MTA must be signed by **both** the recipient and institutional signatory.

Important Note

Export of Identifiable Tissues

If you intend to export individually-identifiable tissue out from Singapore, **explicit consent** must be obtained from the donor prior to the export.

Release of Non-Identifiable Tissues

To obtain non-identifiable tissues from a Tissue Bank (TB) Owner/PI, Tissue Requestors can complete a Tissue Release Form and submit it to the NTU-TBB via [ServiceNow](#) (Research Services > Human Tissue Withdrawal). The TB Owner/PI is to retain a copy of the final completed signed form from the requestor.
