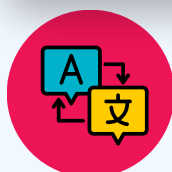
Usage Guide:

KEY STEPS FOR VALID INFORMED CONSENT



Explain the consent information in the
participant's language.



Involve **bilingual witness**, where applicable.



Attach translated short form to English full
consent form.



Provide a copy of signed and dated forms
to the participant, where applicable.



Retain a copy of all documents in **study file**.



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
