**Course Aims**

This foundation level course introduces you to the basic processes of drawing from observation, developing your ability to represent 3D objects on a 2D drawing plane through techniques such as proportion, line quality, tone, and composition. The skills gained will provide a strong basis for any activity that requires development through drawing and offer a valuable foundation for students intending to pursue fields where drawing is an essential tool.

At the end of the course, students will be able to improve their drawing skills and enhance their visualization abilities for a range of future art disciplines. The course also welcomes those who wish to build confidence in drawing as a developing practice.
