Intakes and Application Period

August Intake – 01 October to 15 November, For all four Subject Areas
January Intake – 01 June to 31 July, For Economics, Psychology and Sociology only

Application

Only the **first choice** of the application will be processed. Candidates who wish to be considered for more than one subject will have to submit separate applications. If you wish to be considered for either MA or PhD, separate applications must be submitted. Application fee is payable for every application.

When applying, it is important to provide your email address and contact no. so that we can contact you regarding interviews. Ensure that both email and contact no. are valid.

Admissions Requirements

Admissions Eligibility

Applicants must have Bachelor's degree with minimum Honours (Distinction) or 2nd Class Upper Honours or equivalent and the ability to pursue research in the proposed field of advanced study. For applications to the PPGA and Sociology programmes, a good Master's degree, in addition to a Bachelor's degree, is required.

IELTS / TOEFL

For applicants whose native language is not English, **IELTS** or **TOEFL** test scores must be submitted.

- Test dates must be **within 2 years or less** from the date of application.
- Those who hold a degree from universities (must be at least 3 years of study) where English is the medium of instruction are exempted from the IELTS/TOEFL requirement. A letter from the university indicating the medium of instruction as English must be submitted.

The minimum score requirements for the tests are:

- IELTS: 7.0 (overall)
- TOEFL (iBT): 105 out of 120

GRE

- Applicants applying to the Economics programme is to note that the GRE (General) test is not mandatory, but GRE scores submitted along with applications will be taken into consideration.
- GRE (General) test is required for applicants applying to the Psychology programme if they did not graduate from a Psychology programme at Autonomous Universities in Singapore. Test date must be **within 5 years or less** from the date of application. GATE and GMAT scores are not acceptable.
- GRE is not required for PPGA and Sociology programmes.

Interviews are scheduled between February to March (August Intake) and August to September (January Intake) for shortlisted candidates only and they are conducted via Zoom.

Referee Reports

- Referee reports are confidential and should not be made accessible to applicants.
- Applicants are encouraged to prompt referees to submit report online on time to avoid delays in processing applications.
- Referee report should be typed on a letterhead and duly signed.
