Major-Prescribed Elective Courses

Students who matriculate in Academic Year 2021-2022 onwards are required to complete 41 AUs of Major-Prescribed Electives, within the duration of the four-year degree programme.

Of the 41 AUs, at least 20 AUs must be upper-level PEs (CS4XXX) as opposed to lower-level ones (CS2XXX/FL5XXX). Upper-level courses are generally 4 AUs each. This means you will have to take a minimum of 5 upper-level PEs. You may take more than 20 AUs of upper-level PEs if you wish to.

As part of the 21 AUs of lower-level PEs, students will have to read at least one course from the table below, a compulsory major PE category that comprises of a menu of visual communication courses:
