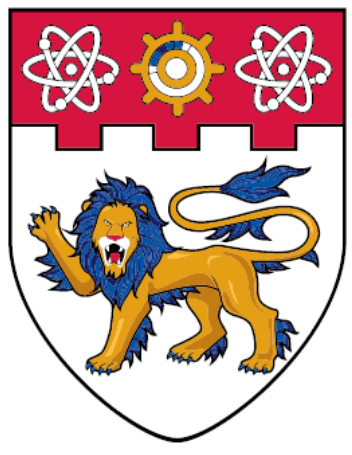

Individualised academic support helped secondary school students in gaining confidence, improving academic performance, cultivating love for learning

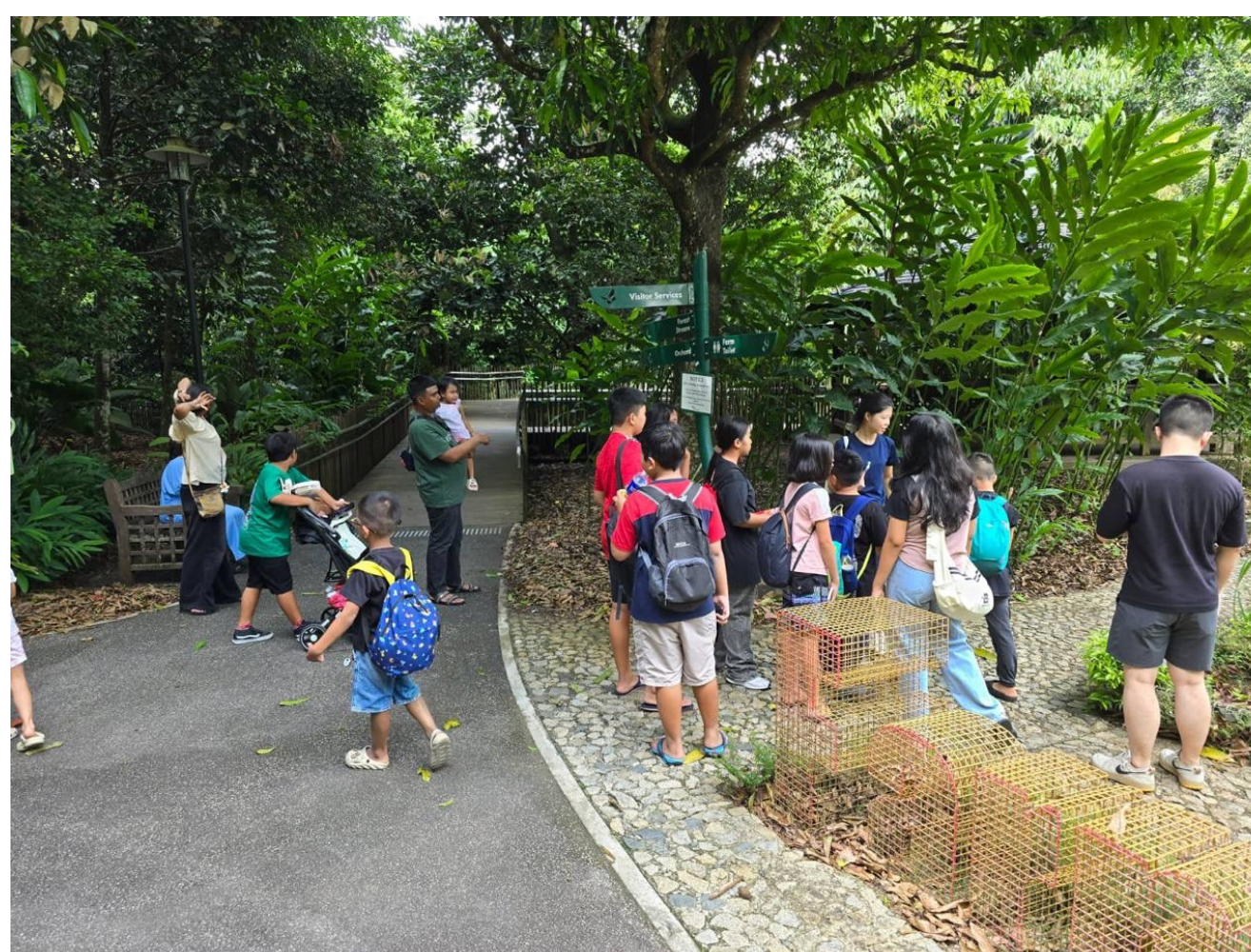

- Bowling for secondary school students

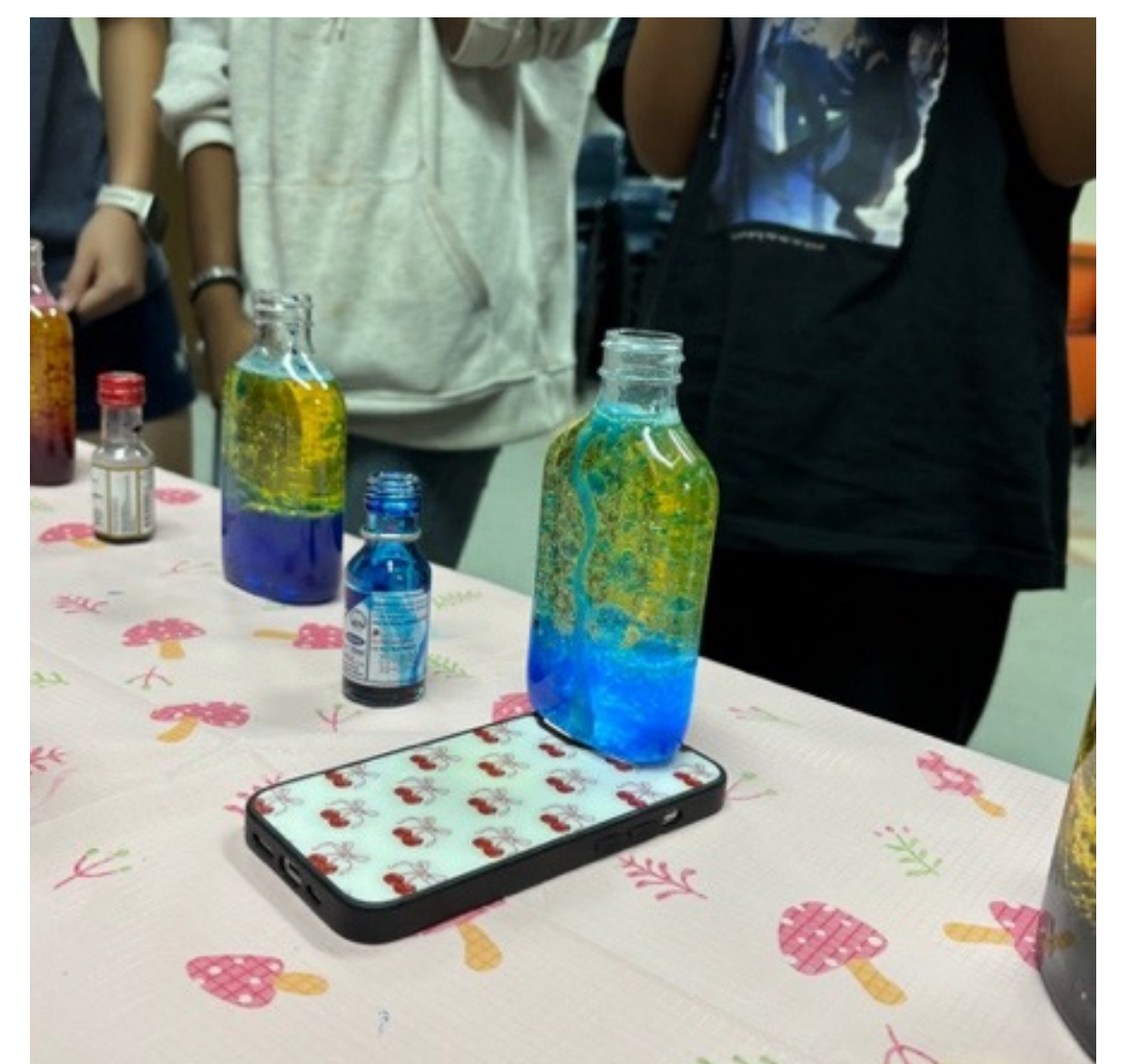
