Research Excellence

Professor Low is an internationally renowned expert in Teacher Education and World Englishes and is constantly invited to deliver keynote addresses in both these disciplines to international scholars and policymakers. She has won numerous local and global competitive grants and her publications are widely cited.

She is an Adjunct Professor at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASS) at the National University of Singapore and was recognised as a Distinguished FASS alumni in 2025. She was also appointed as Honorary Professor at University College London in 2025 and was conferred Honorary Membership by the Japan Association of College English Teachers in 2026.

Professor Low is a governing board member of the International Baccalaureate Organisation (IBO). She was recently elected as President of the International Academy of Education (IAE), a prestigious global academy of leading education scholars dedicated to advancing excellence in educational research and practice.

An associate professor of physical geography, Dr Park is widely recognised as a leading authority on tropical rivers in Southeast Asia. He combines remote sensing, GIS, hydrological modelling, and field surveys to understand how environmental change and human activity reshape river systems.

Since 2023, Dr Park has been listed among Stanford University's top 2% scientists, and in 2026 he was appointed a CAS PIFI International Distinguished Scientist. He is also the recipient of the IAG Early Career Medal in 2025. He has secured major competitive research funding, including two MOE Tier 2, a Tier 3 grant and the NTUitive GAP Fund, and delivered several keynote addresses at international conferences. His research has been cited in several policy reports, including a recent Mekong River Commission (MRC) report.
