

Tuition Fees (Coursework) for Academic Year 2026-2027

Self-financing Programmes

(A) Notes on Tuition Fees:

1. All fees listed below are in Singapore dollars (S\$). Every academic year, fees are reviewed and subject to revision. As and when fees are revised, the new fees will be applicable to all existing and new students. From 1 January 2024, the GST will be increased to 9%.
2. For AY2025 intake only: Singapore Citizens (SC) and Singapore Permanent Residents (SPR) are eligible for a S\$5,000 tuition fee subsidy. An additional fee subsidy of up to S\$10,000 is available for qualifying Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents who meet the eligibility criteria for financial aid. All NTU alumni are eligible for an additional 10% tuition fee subsidy. Fee subsidies are subject to terms and conditions.
3. For AY2024 intake only: Fees stated for Singapore Citizen and Singapore Permanent Resident students are net of applicable subsidy granted by the University. Additional fee subsidy of up to \$5,000 is available for qualifying Singapore Citizen and Singapore Permanent Resident students in need of financial aid. All NTU alumni are eligible for an additional 10% tuition fee subsidy. Fee subsidies are subject to terms and conditions.
4. There are two semesters in an academic year. Fees payable every semester must be paid in advance and within the stipulated period.
5. Students who fail to pay fees within the stipulated periods can have their names struck off the register of graduate students. A student whose name has been thus struck off but who is otherwise eligible to continue his candidature will be reinstated only after he has settled all outstanding fees and paid a re-registration fee of S\$54.50.
6. A student who withdraws or leaves the University two or more weeks after the commencement of his candidature or the commencement of the semester is liable to pay the fees due for the semester.
7. The University's Board of Trustees reserves the right to alter fees at any time without notice.

Total Tuition Fee (by Course Rate)

In general, practicum and dissertation components are each equivalent to two courses. Fees are billed on a semester basis for the number of courses (or equivalent) registered in the semester. The per-course rate is subject to yearly revision. Students have to pay for any component that they have to repeat.
